



Our donors, volunteers, and staff worked hard in 2022!
Here's some of what we accomplished:

Clients had **4,434** counseling sessions — **2,486** in-person and **1,948** telehealth appointments in 2022.

FAMILY COUNSELING CENTER

32 hours of post-adoption assistance were provided to adoptive families.

4 adoptions were finalized, and **6** information sessions were organized for families interested in exploring adoption.

FAMILY ADOPTION PROGRAM

20 parents participated in the young parent program this year.

17 of the participating families received winter essentials from Christmas Program.

JOURNEY PROGRAM (Formerly Teen Parent Education Program)


Maine Children's Home (MCH) has been adapting to the evolving needs of families and children for the past 124 years.

2022 FINANCIAL OVERVIEW

Maine Children's Home utilized endowment funds to support organization cash flow, child care for Journey Program, and to invest in necessary campus upgrades and repairs.

Our use of these funds supports essential program services and is carefully planned and monitored. *In-Kind* support is reported as revenue but is a non-cash transaction. Expenses were maintained at nearly the same level as 2021.
